WELCOME to the Second Edition of PRO STATE of the art

The therapeutic landscape of prostate cancer evolves continuously, leading to new challenges for the clinicians.

In the last two years new strategies and new agents proved their efficacy in a further setting of this disease. Today, patients with nonmetastatic castration-resistant prostate cancer can be managed with old and new generation androgen receptor targeting agents. Also in metastatic castration-sensitive setting the therapeutic options recently increased with enzalutamide and apalutamide. Looking at the future, the first efficacy data of PARP inhibitors provide new perspectives in the metastatic castration-resistant setting. Furthermore, the role of radiotherapy in the treatment of primary tumor in oligometastatic disease is currently under re-evaluation.

The second edition of the meeting "Pro.State of the Art" represents an opportunity for Italian clinicians involved in the treatment of prostate cancer to share their opinions with Italian and European experts in the fields looking at this fluid landscape which is a challenge in the daily clinical practice.
